

Joint Committee on Advanced Practice Nurses Meeting - July 20, 2010

After consideration of the report from the Joint Committee regarding temporary approval having been given by the Alabama Board of Nursing to collaborative practice applicants requesting the additional skill of lumbar puncture, a motion was made to 1) deny the request to allow lumbar puncture and to restate the standard language regarding lumbar puncture privileges; and 2) communicate to the Alabama Board of Nursing, and to the

collaborating physician of the CRNP to whom temporary approval was given for lumbar puncture, that the physician should cease and desist the practice of allowing the CRNP to perform lumbar puncture. The motion was adopted without objection.

After consideration of the report of the Joint Committee regarding an additional skills request of Thermocoagulation of Telangiectasis with Vein Wave, a motion was made to defer consideration of this request pending additional review. The motion was adopted without objection.



A teaching physician at the University of Alabama at Birmingham School of Medicine or the University of South Alabama College of Medicine who holds a certificate of qualification and license pursuant to § 34-24-75(a) of the *Code of Alabama* (2007) (a limited license) must limit his/her medical practice to the confines of the medical center of which the medical school/college is a part, and as an adjunct to his/her teaching functions in that school/college. It is the opinion of the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners that a teaching physician at the University of Alabama at Birmingham School of Medicine or the University of South Alabama College of Medicine who holds a limited license may include in his/her medical practice the provision of telemedicine services which are external to the school/college and rendered from the school/college; provided that the telemedicine services are rendered as an adjunct to the physician's teaching functions in that school/college.

A physician enrolled in a residency training program at the University of Alabama at Birmingham School of Medicine or the University of South Alabama College of Medicine who holds a certificate of qualification and license pursuant to § 34-24-75(c) of the *Code of Alabama* (2007) (a limited license) must limit his/her medical practice to the confines of the institution in which he/she is placed pursuant to his/her training program. It is the opinion of the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners that a physician enrolled in a residency training program at the University of Alabama at Birmingham School of Medicine or the University of South Alabama College of Medicine who holds a limited license may include in his/her medical practice the provision of telemedicine services which are external to the school/college and rendered from the school/college; provided that the telemedicine services are rendered pursuant to his/her training program.




