

Advancement of Oriental Medicine After consideration of a presentation made by Sarita E. Cox, LAc, N.D., and Wendell Mew, M.D., a motion was made to convene a Consultant Group for the Study of Oriental Medicine with members to be appointed at a later date. The motion was adopted without objection.

Administrative Rule 410-2-4-.11, Substance Abuse After consideration of the amendment to Administrative Rule 410-2-4-.11, as published for public comment in the *Alabama Administrative Monthly*, the Credentials Committee recommended that the following comments be submitted on behalf of the Board of Medical Examiners: opioid addiction treatment should be physician office based with treatment by Suboxone rather than by Methadone; there exists insufficient state regulatory authority over Methadone clinics; and the manner in which Methadone clinics currently are managed gives the appearance that economic prosperity is paramount to patient care. The motion was adopted without objection.

Administrative Rule 540-X-7, Appendix D, Application for Licensure of PA; Appendix H, Application for Licensure of AA The Credentials Committee recommended that Administrative Rule Chapter 540-X-7 Appendix D and Appendix H, as amended, be adopted as emergency rules and be approved for publication in the *Alabama Administrative Monthly* for public comment. The motion was adopted without objection.

Administrative Rules 540-X-8-.08 and 540-X-8-.22, Requirements for Collaborative Practice The Credentials Committee recommended that the amendments to Administrative Rules 540-X-8-.08 and 540-X-8-.22 be approved for publication in the *Alabama Administrative Monthly* for public comment. 
