

UAB School of Medicine - E-Visit Proposed Study The Credentials Committee recommended that the UAB School of Medicine's proposed E-Visit research project be approved. The motion was adopted without objection.

UAB School of Medicine - Office Based Surgery / Performance of Cataract Surgery After consideration of correspondence from Christopher A. Girkin, M.D., Charles Brian Spraberry, and Jason C. Swanner, M.D., regarding the performance of cataract surgery in an office-based setting, the Credentials Committee recommended that the physicians be notified that, pursuant to 540-X-10-.01, the physician must decide on a case by case basis the location and level of service that is best for the physician's particular patient and procedure; this decision must always be made with the patient's best interest in mind. Any physician choosing to perform surgery outside a hospital or outpatient facility licensed by


the ADPH must adhere to the requirements stated in Administrative Rule Chapter 540-X-10, Office-Based Surgery. The motion was adopted without objection.


