Administrative Rule Chapter 540-X-12, Appendices A and B, P.A. QACSC The Credentials Committee recommended that Administrative Rule Chapter 540-X-12, Appendices A and B be approved for final adoption. The motion was adopted without objection.

CRNP / CNM QACSC Formulary After consideration by the full Board, a motion was made to amend the proposed CRNP / CNM QACSC Formulary to include a notation that, regarding the prescribing of anorectic drugs, reference should be made to Administrative Rule Chapter 540-X-17, Guidelines and Standards for the Utilization of Controlled Substances for Weight Reduction. The motion was adopted without objection.

CRNP / CNM QACSC Prescribing Protocol The Credentials Committee recommended approval of the CRNP / CNM QACSC Prescribing Protocol. The motion was adopted without objection.

ACLS / PALS / TLS Certification / Accreditation and CME Repository The Credentials Committee recommended that Administrative Rule Chapter 540-X-14 and Chapter 540-X-7 be amended to deem nationally recognized resuscitation certification / life support courses, not otherwise accredited for AMA PRA Category 1 credit, excluding basic life support, to be equivalent to 2 hours of AMA PRA Category 1 credit for the purpose of meeting the requirement for annual renewal of a medical license or P.A. license. The Committee recommended that this amendment become effective January 1, 2014, for license renewal for calendar year 2015. The Committee recommended that the issue of a CME repository be tabled indefinitely. The motion was adopted without objection.

Alabama Board of Medical Examiners 457(b) Plan The Credentials Committee recommended that the Board adopt a 457(b) plan for the benefit of its employees, Board members and Commission members. After consideration by the full Board, a motion was made to adopt the following resolution:

Resolved, that the Alabama State Board of Medical Examiners is authorized and directed to restate its 457(b) plan for the benefit of its employees, board members and commission members to allow for matching contributions and to make other changes to the plan as determined by the Executive Director of the Board of Medical Examiners. Resolved, further, that the Executive Director of the Board of Medical Examiners is empowered to take such action as he may deem necessary or appropriate in connection with the restated plan.

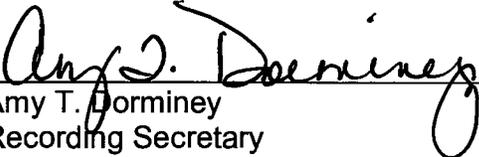
