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
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Declaratory Ruling - Request Re: Alabama Limited Liability Company Law of 2014 After consideration of correspondence from John Ward Weiss, Esq., submitted jointly to the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners and to the Medical Licensure Commission, requesting the issuance of a Declaratory Ruling regarding the provision of professional services as related to the Alabama Limited Liability Company Law of 2014, the Credentials Committee recommended that it be jointly declared: 1) A "Qualified Person" under Section 10A-5A-1.02(o) of the Act shall include licensed physicians and any entities otherwise allowed to employ physicians pursuant to the prior rulings of the Commission or the Board. Such entities would include professional corporations, non-profit corporations, business corporations, partnerships, joint ventures and limited liability companies formed under or otherwise subject to the terms of the Act, which shall be known as the Alabama Limited Liability Company Law of 2014; and 2) The Board's previous letter of June 26, 2008, is limited in scope and application to limited liability companies formed under or otherwise subject to the Alabama Limited Liability Company Law, or earlier versions of the law governing limited liability companies in Alabama, and shall not apply to any limited liability company formed under or otherwise subject to the Act, which shall be known as the Alabama Limited Liability Company Law of 2014. The motion was adopted without objection.




