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

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

APN Miscellaneous Requests / Reports

Vascular Access Procedures The Credentials Committee recommended that, for initial certification, the standard language for vascular access procedures be revised to require the completion of five supervised procedures of each requested procedure. The motion was adopted without objection.

The revised standard language will read as follows:

Vascular Access Procedures: In allowing for the overlapping skills required for placement of central venous lines, internal jugular; central venous lines, femoral; radial arterial lines; and femoral arterial lines, a combined overall total of 50 procedures for initial certification in all four procedures is required, and a combined overall total of 20 procedures per year for maintenance of certification in all four procedures is required. The documentation of training, to be submitted for Board approval, should include documented physician supervised performances of at least five of each requested procedure, with the provision that a maximum of 50% of the total procedures required for initial certification and annual maintenance certification are permitted to be performed in the simulation lab with the understanding that it is the Board's preference that 100% of the maintenance of certification procedures be obtained through the performance of live procedures. The documentation of training should clearly identify lab and live procedures as well as the anatomical site.

A mid-level practitioner who performs placement of three or less of the following procedures, central venous line, internal jugular; central venous line, femoral; radial arterial line; or femoral arterial line, is required to perform 20 documented procedures of each requested procedure for initial certification and 10 documented procedures of each procedure for annual maintenance certification with the provision that a maximum of 50% of the total procedures are permitted to be performed in the simulation lab with the stipulation that it is the Board's preference that 100% of the maintenance of certification procedures be obtained through the performance of live procedures. The Committee recommended that the documentation of training should clearly identify lab and live procedures as well as the anatomical site.

Michael J. Boucher, M.D. / Diantha O. Miller, CRNP The Credentials Committee recommended that a letter of clarification be requested concerning the physician's training to perform chemical peels. The motion was adopted without objection.

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John N. McAtee, M.D. / Cathy McAtee, CRNP The Credentials Committee recommended approval of the documentation of the CRNP having been trained to perform arterial line placement and central line placement, excluding the training for subclavian access. The Committee recommended that Dr. McAtee be advised of the Board's revised language regarding subclavian access. The Committee recommended denial of the request to train the CRNP to perform thoracentesis and chest tube placement. The motion was adopted without objection.




