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



Administrative Rule Chapter 540-X-20, Limited Purpose Schedule II Permit The Credentials Committee recommended that Administrative Rule Chapter 540-X-20 be approved for final adoption. The Credentials Committee recommended that a response be sent to the Alabama Board of Nursing in regards to the suggested amendment. The motion was adopted without objection.

Alabama Board of Nursing - Hormone Pellet Therapy The Credentials Committee recommended that this item be received as information. The motion was adopted without objection.

Telehealth - MyidealDoctor The Credentials Committee recommended that, at the request of MYidealDoctor, consideration of this item be deferred to the November meeting. The Committee recommended that additional information be requested regarding a practice model and the plan's specific sponsorship, i.e., contracted insurance plan, patient employer, hospital system, etc. The motion was adopted without objection.

Telehealth - Teladoc After consideration of correspondence from Teladoc, the Credentials Committee recommended that the Board's previous stipulation that medical treatment may only be provided via Teladoc to those patients participating in a contracted



insurance plan be clarified to confirm that treatment may be provided to those patients who participate through the following Teladoc sponsored clients: insurance plans / companies; employers; or hospital systems. The motion was adopted without objection.

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
