CURRENT BUSINESS

Administrative Rule 540-X-12-.05(3) Renewal of a QACSC, PA / 540-X-18-.05(2) Renewal of a QACSC, CRNP/CNM The Credentials Committee recommended that amendments to Administrative Rules 540-X-12-.05(3) and 540-X-18-.05(2) be drafted which would require a mid-level practitioner to obtain Board approval of the four (4) AMA PRA Category 1 credits™ or equivalent regarding the prescribing of controlled substances which are required every two years for the renewal of a QACSC. The motion was adopted without objection.

Administrative Rule 540-X-19-.02(9)(c) Pain Management Services The Credentials Committee recommended that 540-X-19-.02(9)(c), which defines a provider of pain management services as any physician listed in the top 3% of providers who prescribe controlled substances, be deleted in its entirety and that the amendment be filed as an emergency rule and be published for public comment in the *Alabama Administrative Monthly*.

The Committee recommended that a provider of pain management services be defined only as stated in (a) and (b) of 540-X-19-.02(9): a physician practice which advertises or holds itself out to the public as a provider of pain management services; or a physician practice which dispenses opioids.

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After consideration by the full Board of the preceding recommendations, a motion was made to table the Credentials Committee's recommendation and to defer any consideration of Administrative Rule 540-X-19-.02 until the January 2015 meeting. The motion was adopted without objection.


Administrative Rule Chapter 540-X-21, Guidelines for the Treatment of Opioid Addiction in the Medical Office The Credentials Committee recommended that 540-X-21-.03(8)(c) be amended as directed by the Committee and that the amended rule be brought back for further consideration. The motion was adopted without objection.

Consultant Group for the Safe Prescribing and Abuse Preventive Measures for Extended Release Opioid Analgesics The Credentials Committee recommended that formation of the Consultant Group continue to be deferred at this time. The motion was adopted without objection.

Consultant Group for the Study of Hormone Pellet Therapy The Credentials Committee recommended that formation of the Consultant Group be tabled to allow the Board to further research this matter. The motion was adopted without objection.

Telehealth - American Well The Credentials Committee recommended that the request for exemption be deferred in order to invite American Well representatives to meet with the full Board. The motion was adopted without objection.

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




