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

A motion was made to adopt the Credentials Committee's recommendations for items one through sixteen. The motion was adopted without objection.

Mid-Level Critical Care Protocol Pursuant to radial arterial line insertion and chest tube removal being included in certain specialty standard protocols for nurse practitioners, the Credentials Committee recommended that the procedures be removed from the middle level procedure and vascular access procedure protocols.

The Committee recommended that the training requirement for the three remaining vascular access procedures, central venous line insertion, internal jugular; central venous line insertion, femoral; and femoral arterial line insertion, be modified to require the documented performance of 10 of each individually requested procedure. The Committee recommended that a cumulative total of 25 documented procedures be allowed for simultaneous training of all three procedures conditioned upon each individual procedure being performed a minimum a five times with a minimum of three being live procedures. The remaining number of each procedure may be performed in a simulation lab. All documentation must identify the anatomical site, and whether the procedures were performed on a live patient or in the simulation lab. The motion was adopted without objection.
