

Angelo Gaffo Llontop, M.D. / Yolanda Bowie, CRNP The Credentials Committee recommended approval of the request for standard orthopedic specialty protocol including the request to train the CRNP to perform injections of the glenohumeral and the subacromial joints. The Committee recommended denial of the request to train the CRNP to perform injections of the bicipital tendon, wrist, trigger finger, carpal tunnel, and deQuervains tenosynovitis. The motion was adopted without objection.

T. Michael McIntyre, M.D. / Joshua Allen Posey, CRNP After consideration of a request from Dr. McIntyre, the Credentials Committee recommended that Dr. McIntyre be allowed to pay the collaboration registration fee and that the collaborative agreement be retroactively approved for the calendar year 2015. The motion was adopted without objection.

Joshua Wharton, M.D. / Amelia M. 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


