

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recommended that the Board issue a Declaratory Ruling stating the following: A physician defendant, in a malpractice lawsuit, who has made a payment pursuant to a Hi/Low agreement entered into with a plaintiff before a judicial determination of the case by a judge or jury, in which there was a dismissal or determination of no liability of the defendant by the judge or jury, is not required, under the reporting requirements of Ala. Code § 34-24-56(1), to report the payment to the Board, and, pertaining to that particular payment, may answer "no" to question twelve of the Application for Certificate to Practice Medicine Through Endorsement which asks, *Have you ever had a judgement rendered against you, or action settled relating to performance of your professional service?* The motion was adopted without objection.

Request for Opinion - Delegation by a Physician of Tissue Processing/Cutting Procedures to a Certified Medical Assistant After consideration of a request from Craig Elmets, M.D., UAB Department of Dermatology, the Credentials Committee recommended that Dr. Elmets be notified that the Board has no jurisdiction concerning the scope of practice of a certified medical assistant and defers to UAB's regulations and protocols. The motion was adopted without objection.

Lynde Crowder - Legal Secretary The Credentials Committee recommended that the employment of Ms. Lynde Crowder be approved. The motion was adopted without objection.




